Proposed Change

JP117 Sections/Classes Restricted to Junior, Amateur/Owner, Amateur or Young [CHAPTER JP-3 SECTION SPECIFICATIONS]

1. Amateur Owner Jumper: A horse that is ridden by an Amateur Owner or an amateur member of the owner's family. In either case, classes are restricted to riders who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. **Riders must be listed as the owner or co-owner of the horse or entity that owns the horse on the Federation Horse Recording.** Leased horses are not eligible, and multiple ownership is not permitted unless all owners are members of the same family.

Rule Change Intent

There's currently no way to check if riders in Amateur Owner classes own the horse they are riding or are a family member of the owner. This requirement will enable automatic checking of results in these classes and if the rider is not listed on the Horse Recording or is an owner of the entity on the Horse Recording, the horse will receive Amateur Jumper points rather than Amateur Owner Jumper points.
