HJ141 Position of Animal [CHAPTER SUBCHAPTER HJ-6 MEASUREMENT]

1. The animal must stand squarely on all four feet in such a position that the front legs are vertical to the ground and the back of the hocks are in a vertical line with the point of the animal's quarters. ~~The poll must be in the same horizontal plane as the withers and no lower and the head should be in a normal position.~~ **The head should be in a normal/natural position and the poll may be no lower than the withers.**
