JP111 Tack and Attire [CHAPTER JP-1 GENERAL]

3. Draw Reins/German Martingales. Draw reins and German Martingales may only be used when schooling or in classes with no prize money that are offered at 1.20m or below. Ponies may not be ridden by a Junior in draw reins or German martingales at any time. No other head set devices (chambon, etc.) are permitted in any class. **Draw Reins and German Martingales are not permitted in age restricted classes.**

The intent of this change is to prohibit the use of draw reins and german martingales in age restricted classes. Five year old classes are less than 1.20m and not all six year old classes offer prize money so draw reins and German martingales could be used those.
